<p><b>May Include:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Direct student interaction</li> <li>• One-on-one time with students</li> <li>• Be conducted outside the view of staff or other adults</li> <li>• Involve access to confidential information</li> </ul>	<p><b>Will Include:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Driving STUDENTS</b> <i>in addition to a level 1 or level 3 volunteer</i></li> <li>• <b>DOES NOT INCLUDE DRIVING SELF</b></li> </ul>	<p><b>May Include:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Involve access to confidential information</li> <li>• Be conducted in a setting determined by the volunteer</li> <li>• Overnight <b>supervision</b></li> <li>• Be conducted in a private home or a community setting</li> </ul> <p><b>Will Include:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solitary time with students</li> <li>• Be conducted outside the view of staff/other adults</li> <li>• Be conducted in a setting <b>not accessible</b> to staff</li> </ul>
<p><b>Must:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be conducted in a setting that <b>is accessible</b> to staff or other adults at any time</li> <li>• Provide copy of valid Driver's License or State issued ID card(recommended)</li> <li>• Agree to a criminal history background check</li> </ul>	<p><b>Must:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide copy of valid Driver's License</li> <li>• Provide copy of vehicle Registration</li> <li>• Provide copy of proof of Insurance</li> <li>• Agree to a criminal history background check</li> <li>• Be at least 21 yrs. old &amp; a non-student</li> </ul>	<p><b>Must:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide Livescan fingerprints at the cost of the volunteer</li> <li>• Agree to a criminal history background check</li> <li>• Provide copy of valid Driver's License or State issued ID card (required)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Examples:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• After school assistance</li> <li>• Club Leader</li> <li>• Class day field trip chaperone</li> <li>• Library, classroom, lunchroom &amp; playground</li> <li>• Hallway hero</li> <li>• PYP exhibition mentor</li> <li>• Special events volunteer</li> <li>• Reading buddy</li> <li>• Picture parent</li> </ul>	<p><b>Examples:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Responsible for driving students to a school activity/competition</li> <li>• Responsible for driving athletes to a game/meet</li> <li>• Driving students to a school function when a school bus is unavailable</li> </ul>	<p><b>Examples:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Chaperone for an over-night field trip</li> <li>• Volunteer Athletic Coaches</li> <li>• Volunteer School Service Leader(<b>without</b> staff accessibility-ex. running an activity or club practice or dress rehearsal)</li> </ul>
